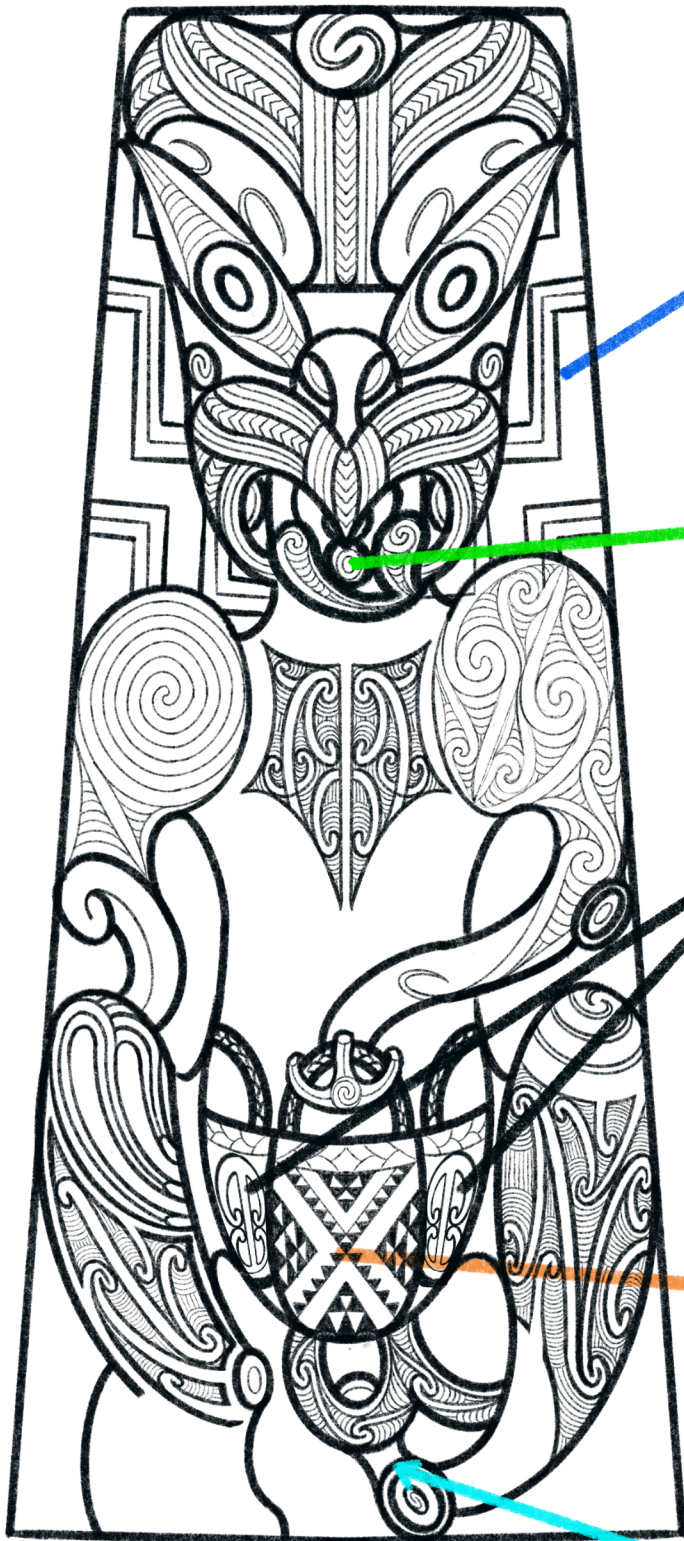




This Pou represents Nga Kaiako/ Kaitiaki o te Kura holding Nga Kete O Te Wananga/ Baskets of Knowledge.
